History

Lake Compounce was founded on October 6, 1846 when Bristol Scientist, Samuel Botsford, persuaded property owner Gad Norton, an original settler descendant, to let him conduct "a series of beautiful experiments in electricity." Well publicized, the event drew thousands of spectators who came to witness the demonstration. Although the final experiment of "blowing up from shore, two huge jugs of gunpowder tied under a raft in the middle of the lake" failed, it did inspire Mr. Norton to create a picnic park offering activates for guests from all over Connecticut.
